The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 10** has **39,499** people, which is **1.44%** from the ideal. **21%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

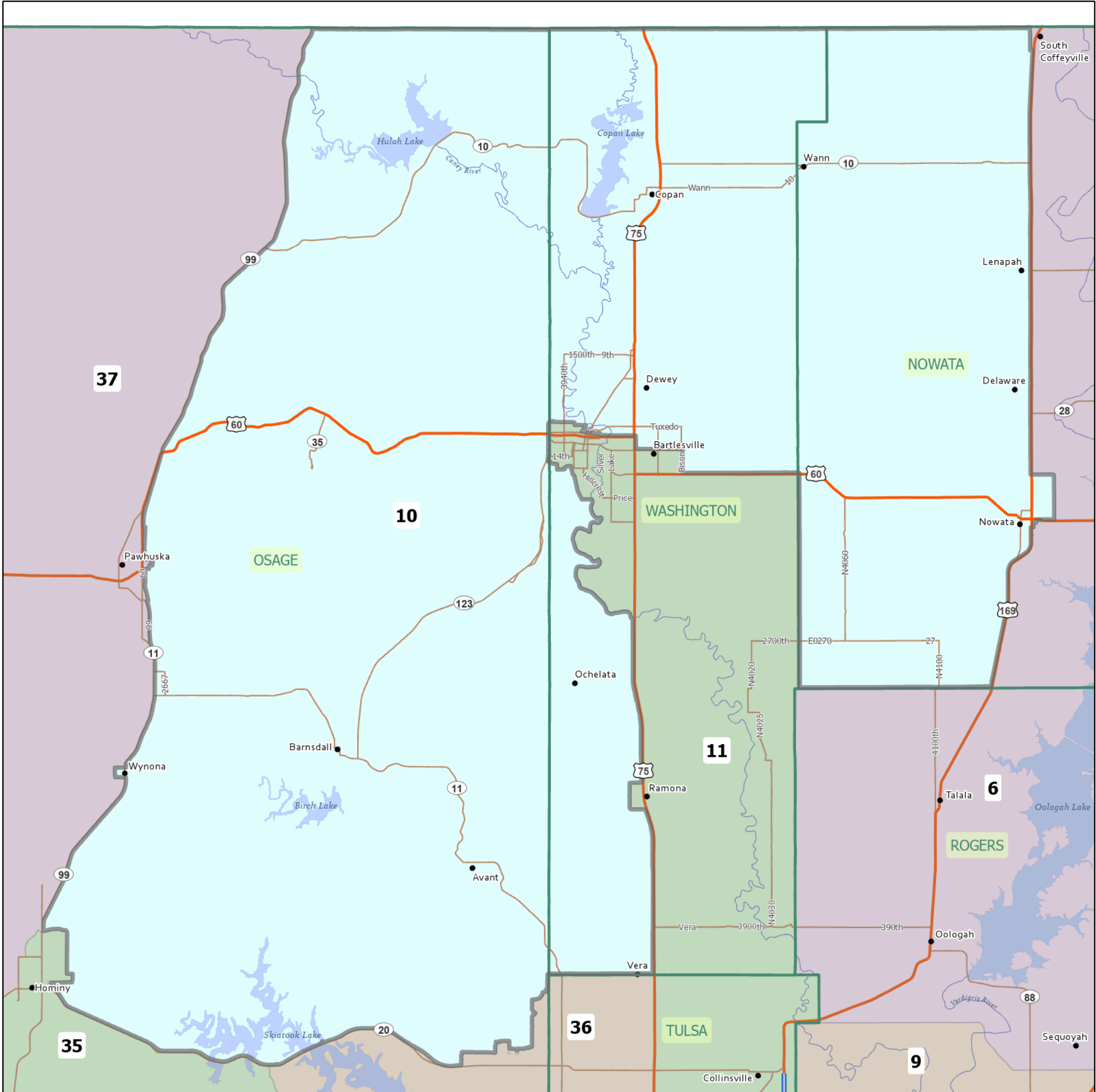
- 19.93% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.55% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 3.48% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.08% of the district is Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 70.22% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 1.71% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 5.64% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

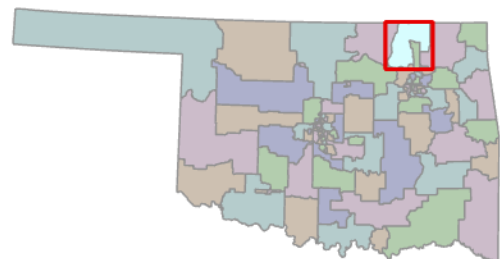
