

# HD 14 | Rep. Chris Sneed

The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 14** has **38,666** people, which is **-0.7%** from the ideal. **18%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

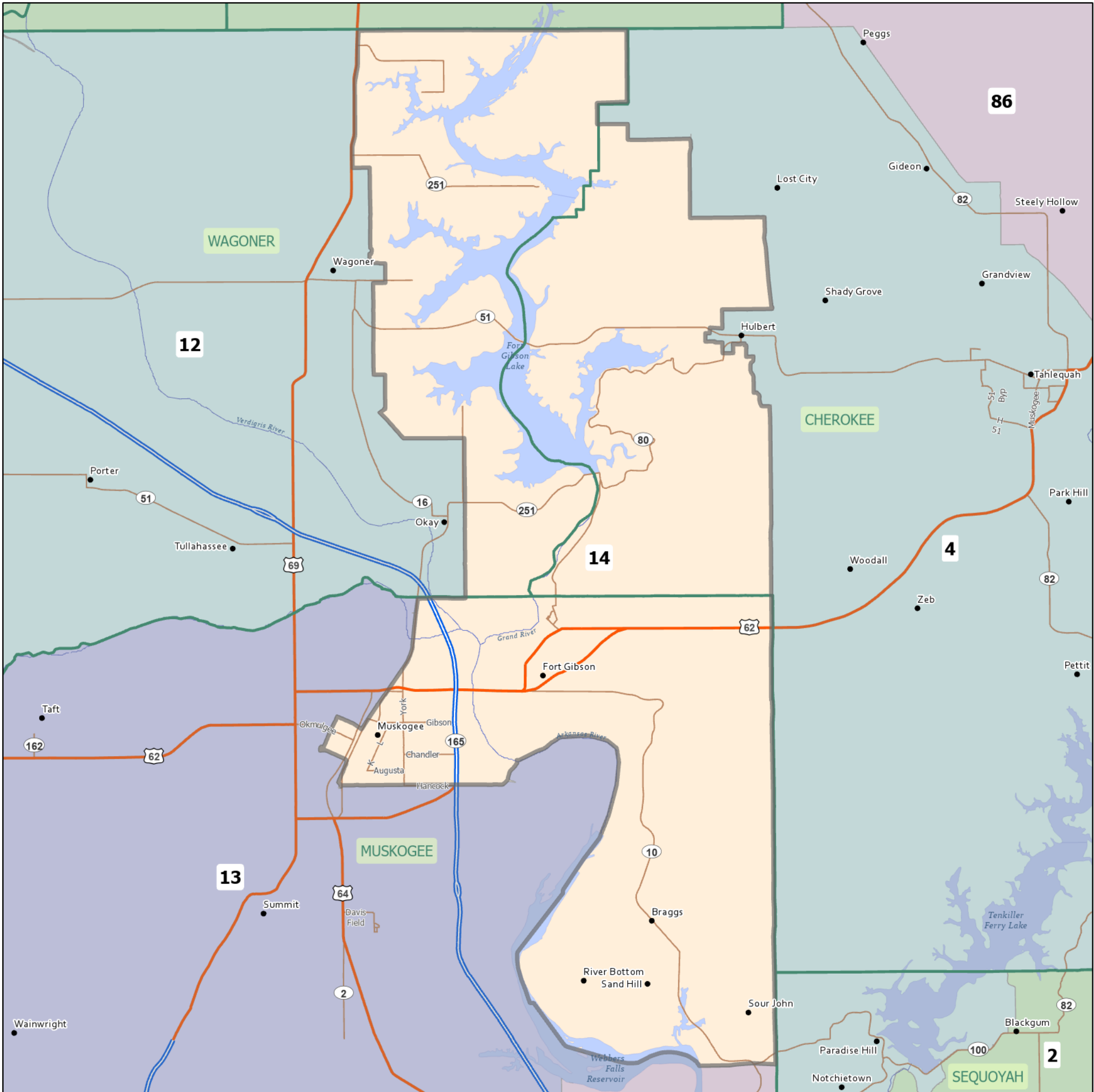
- 28.2% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.8% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 8.37% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.04% of the district is Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 57.26% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 4.16% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 7.36% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

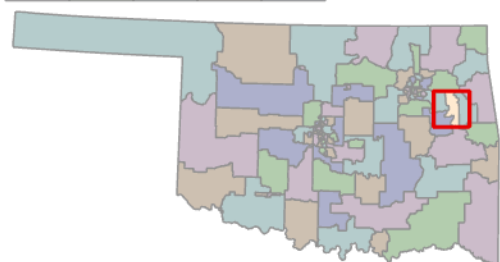
