The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 24** has **39,011** people, which is **0.18%** from the ideal. **85%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

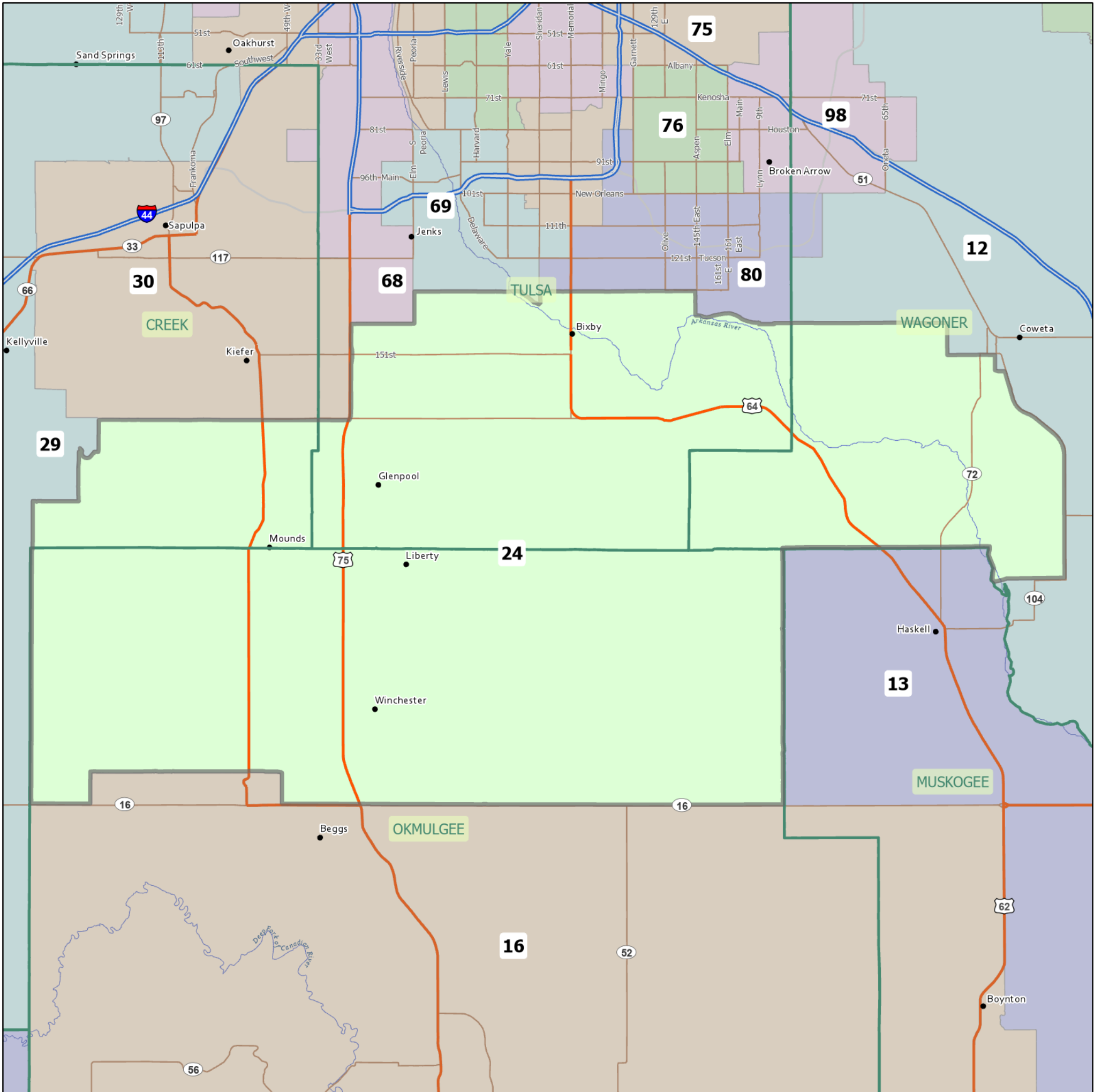
- 15.31% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 4.65% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 73.04% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 1.53% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 6.83% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

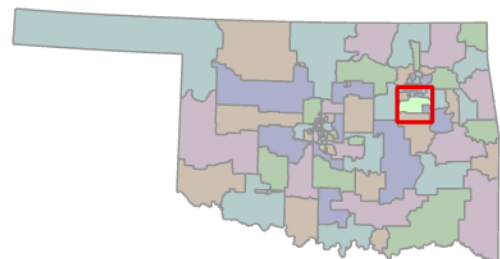
