

# HD 29 | Rep. Kyle Hilbert

The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 29** has **39,187** people, which is **0.64%** from the ideal. **18%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

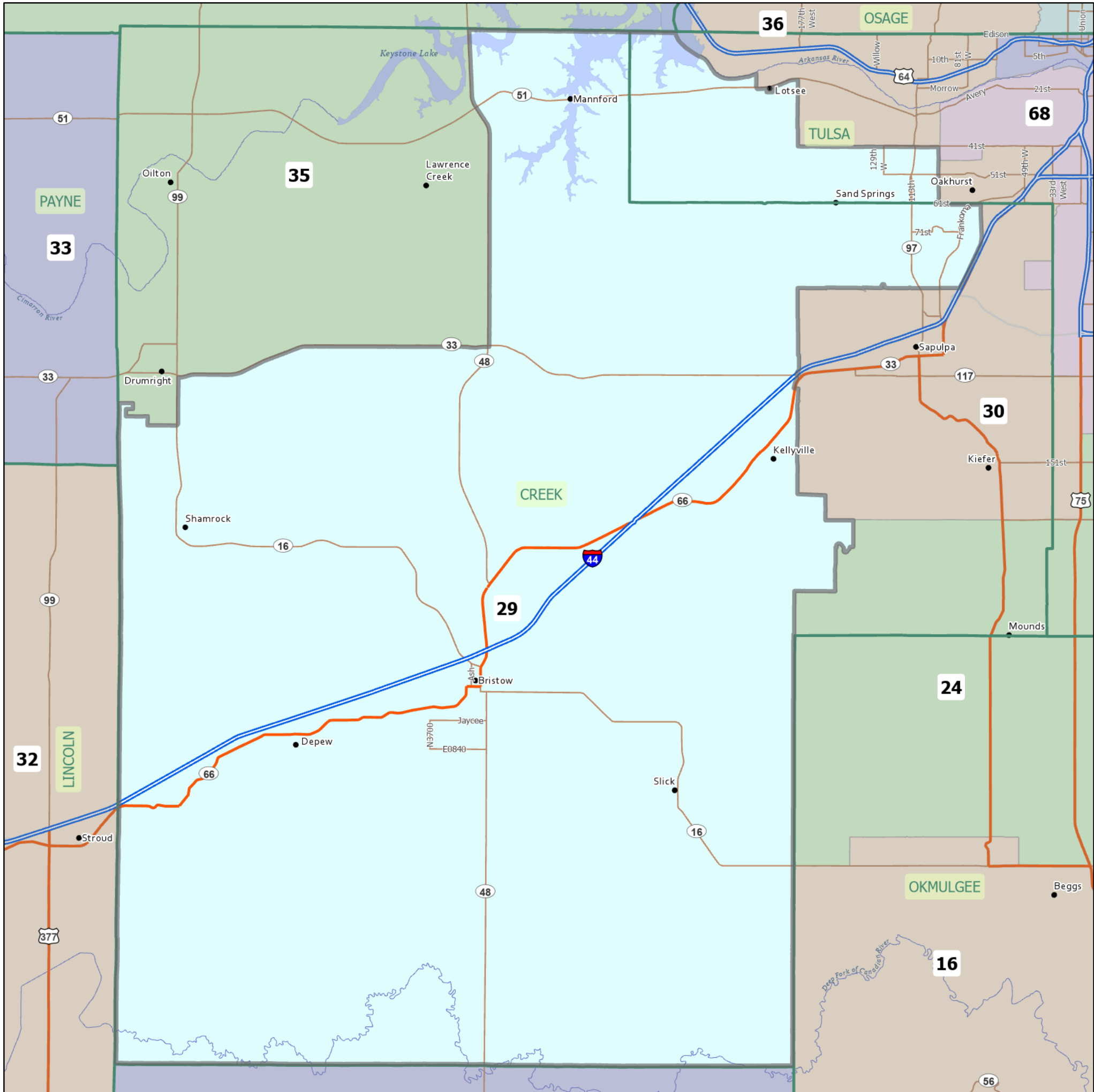
- 16.49% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.82% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 3.17% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.02% of the district is Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 77.09% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 0.77% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 3.49% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

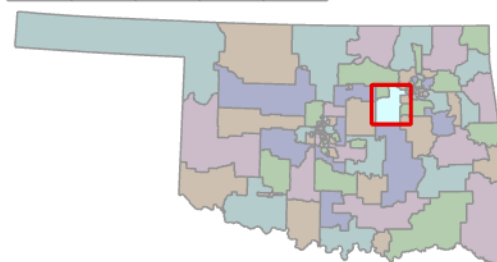
