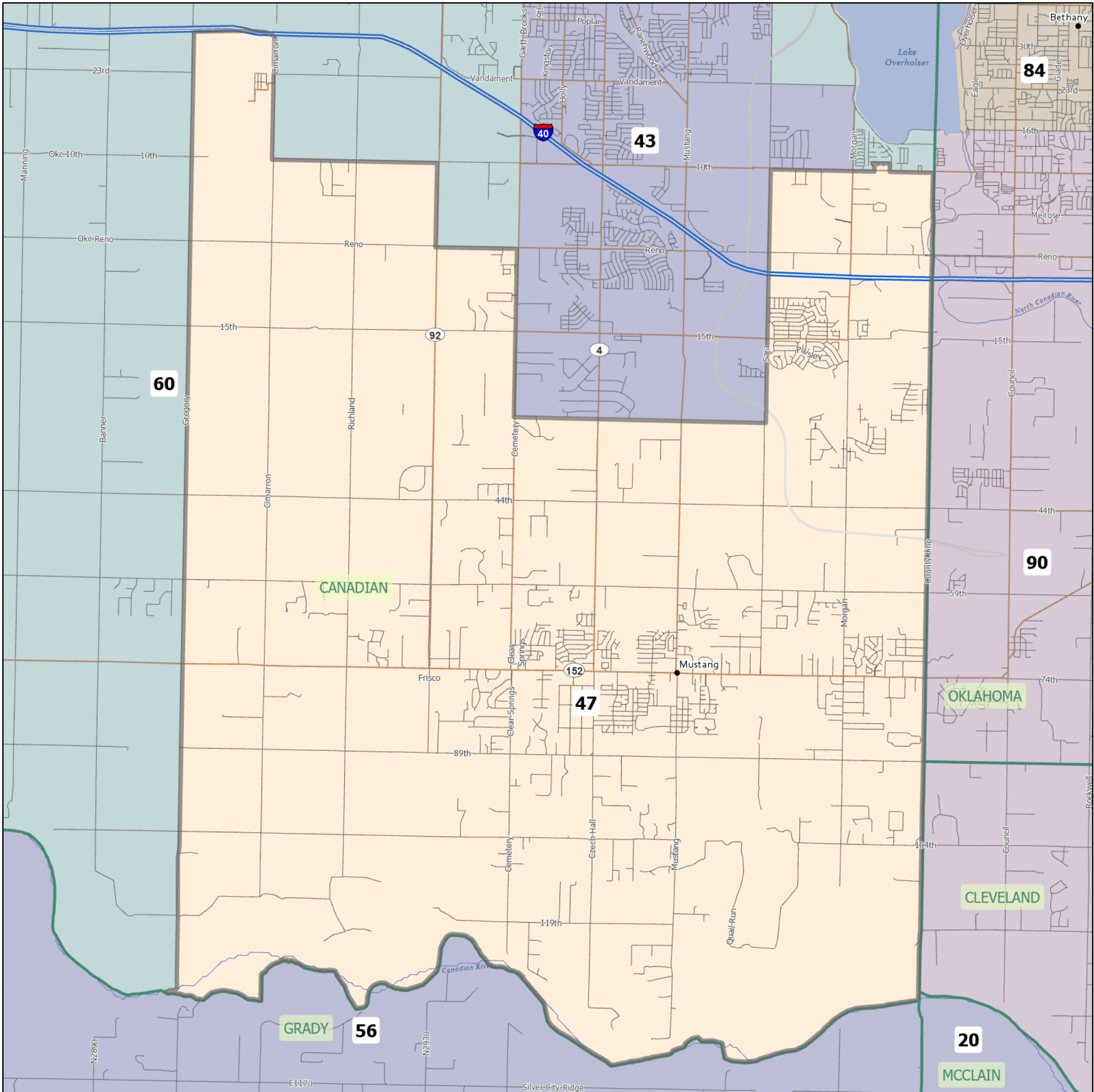
- 7.42% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 78.97% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 2.92% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 6.37% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

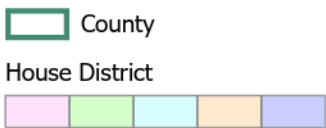
