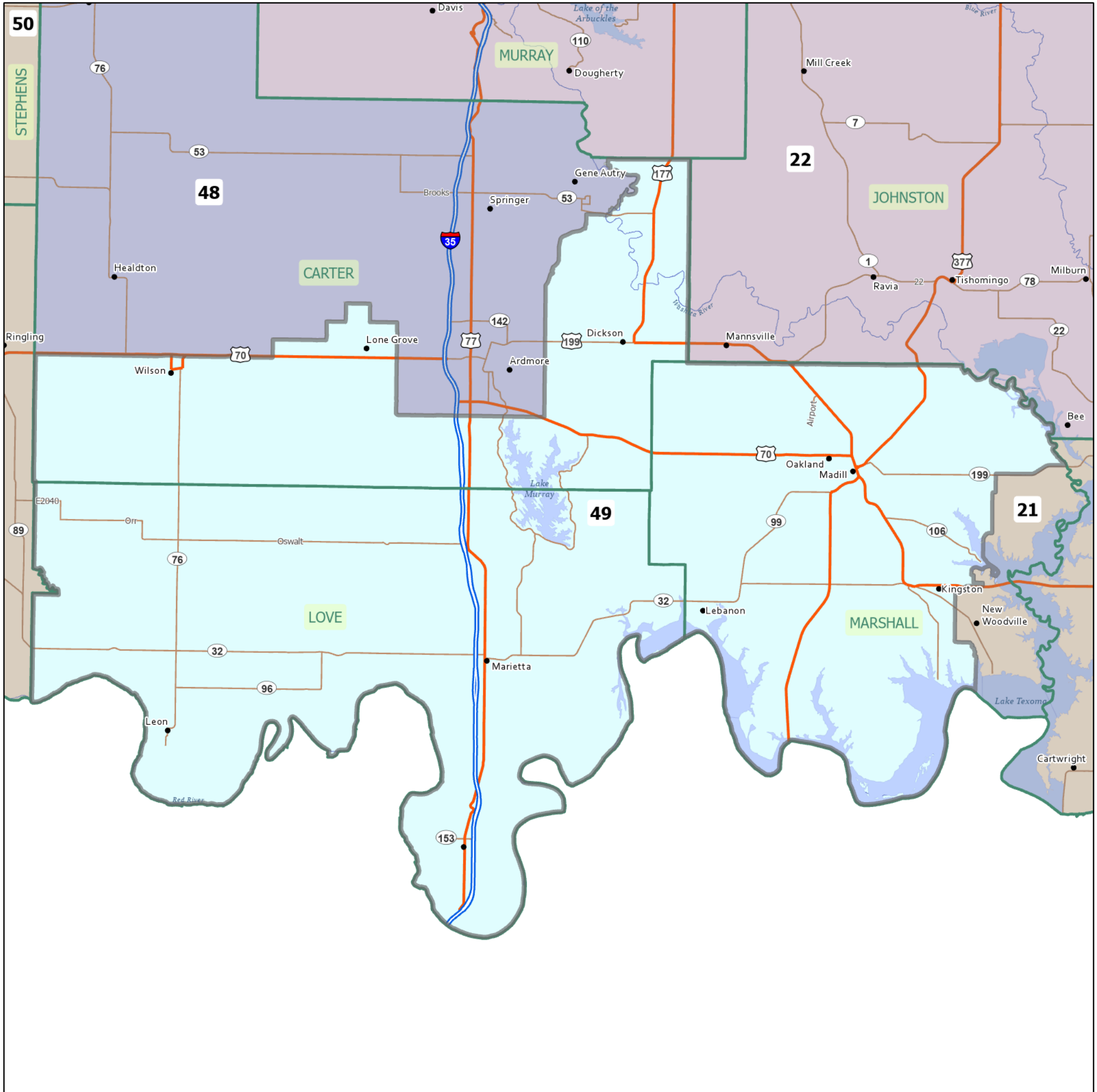
- 14.34% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 70.52% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 6.01% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 12.42% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

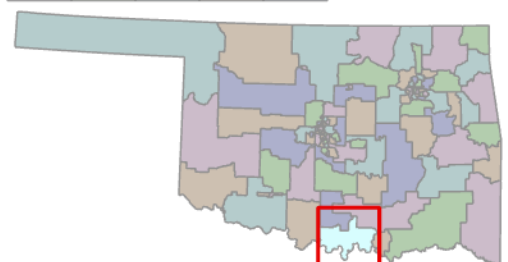
