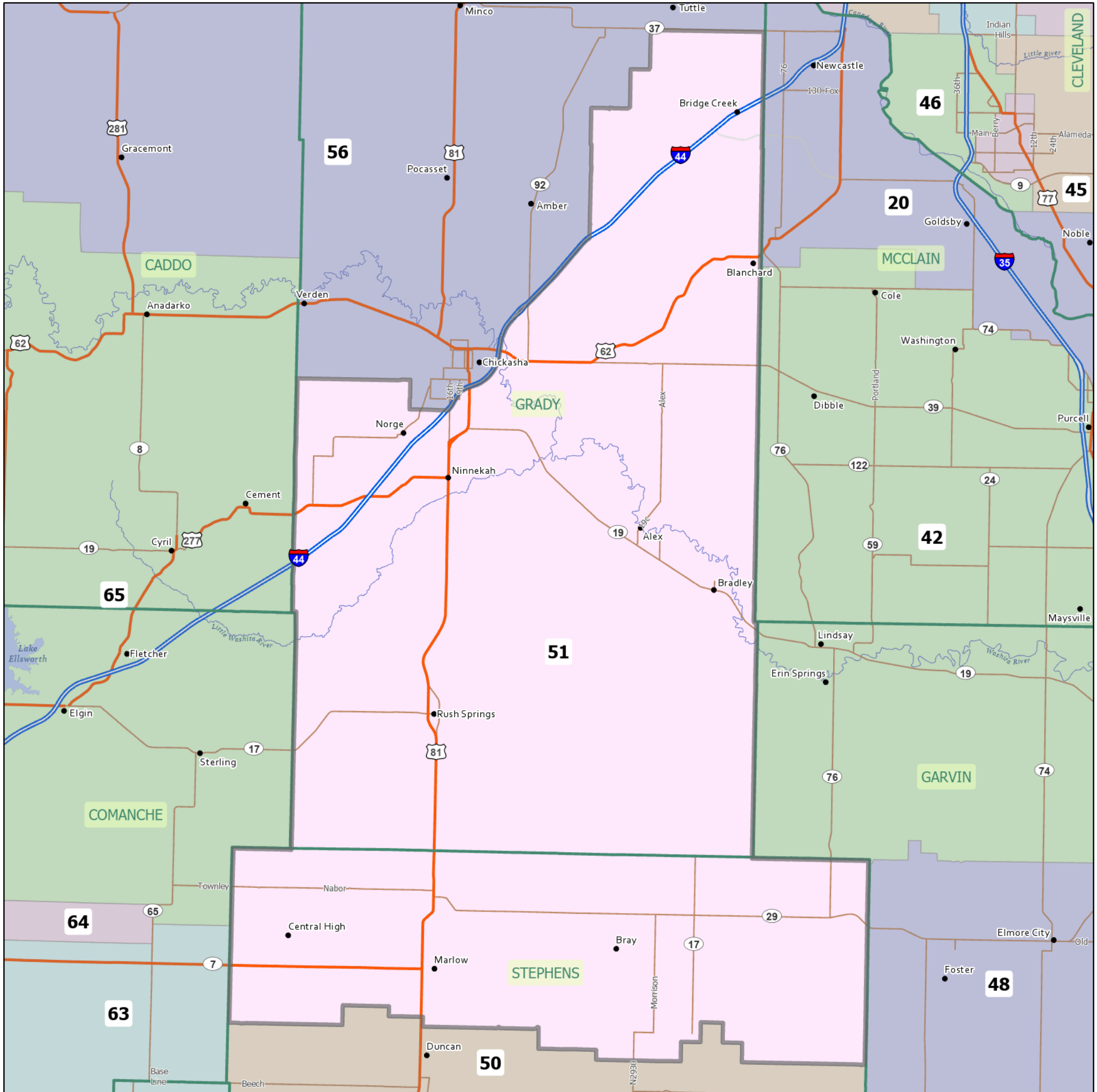
- 9.4% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

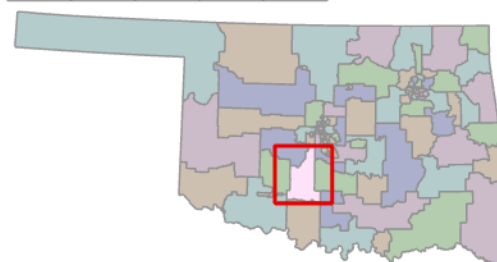
