The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 57** has **38,640** people, which is **-0.77%** from the ideal. **13%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

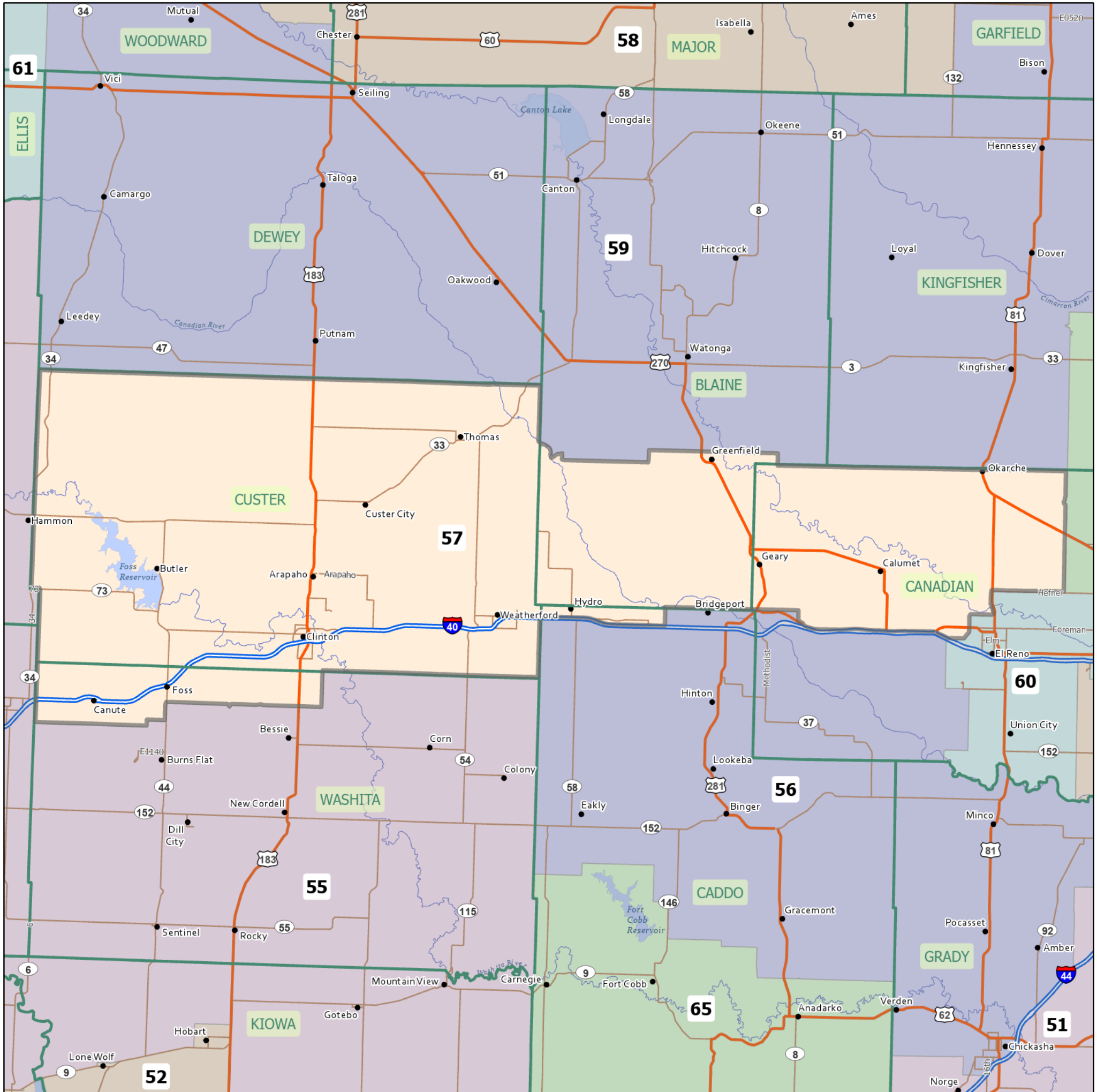
- 10.34% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 70.97% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 3.85% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 15.41% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

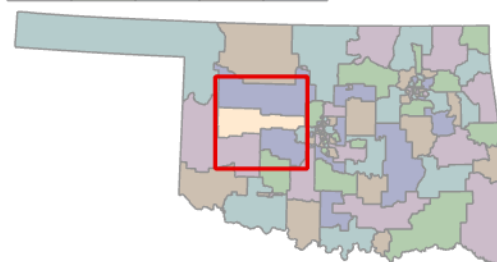
