The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 59** has **39,434** people, which is **1.27%** from the ideal. **24%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

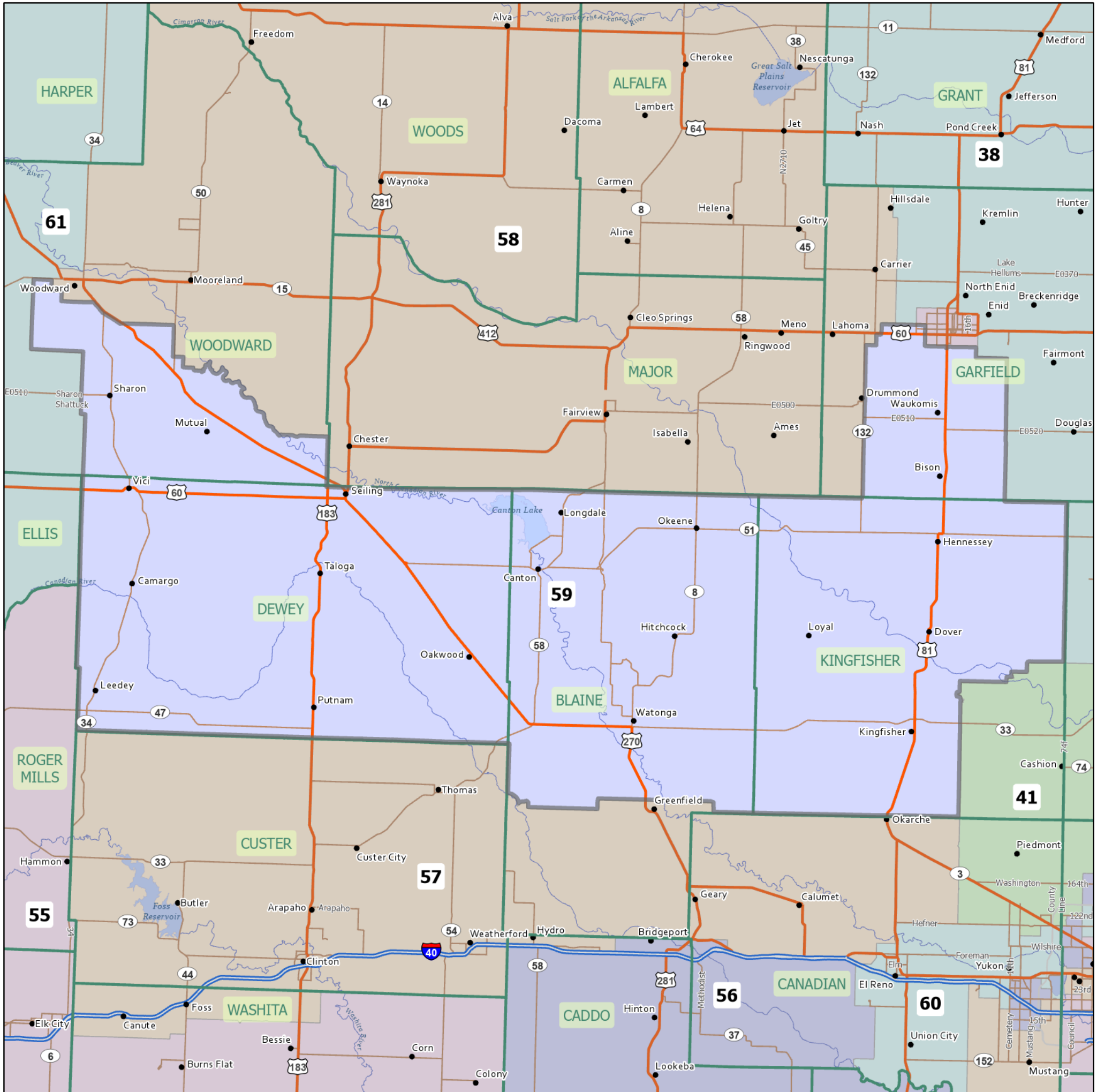
- 6.73% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

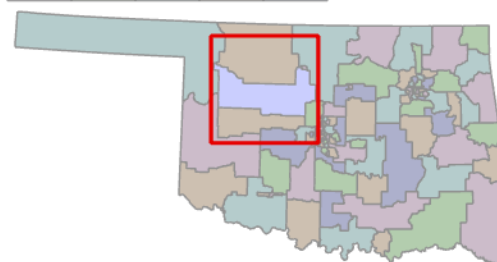
