The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 61** has **38,578** people, which is **-0.93%** from the ideal. **5%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 4.04% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.96% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 2.08% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.02% of the district is Native Hawaiian and other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 58.95% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 17.53% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 33% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

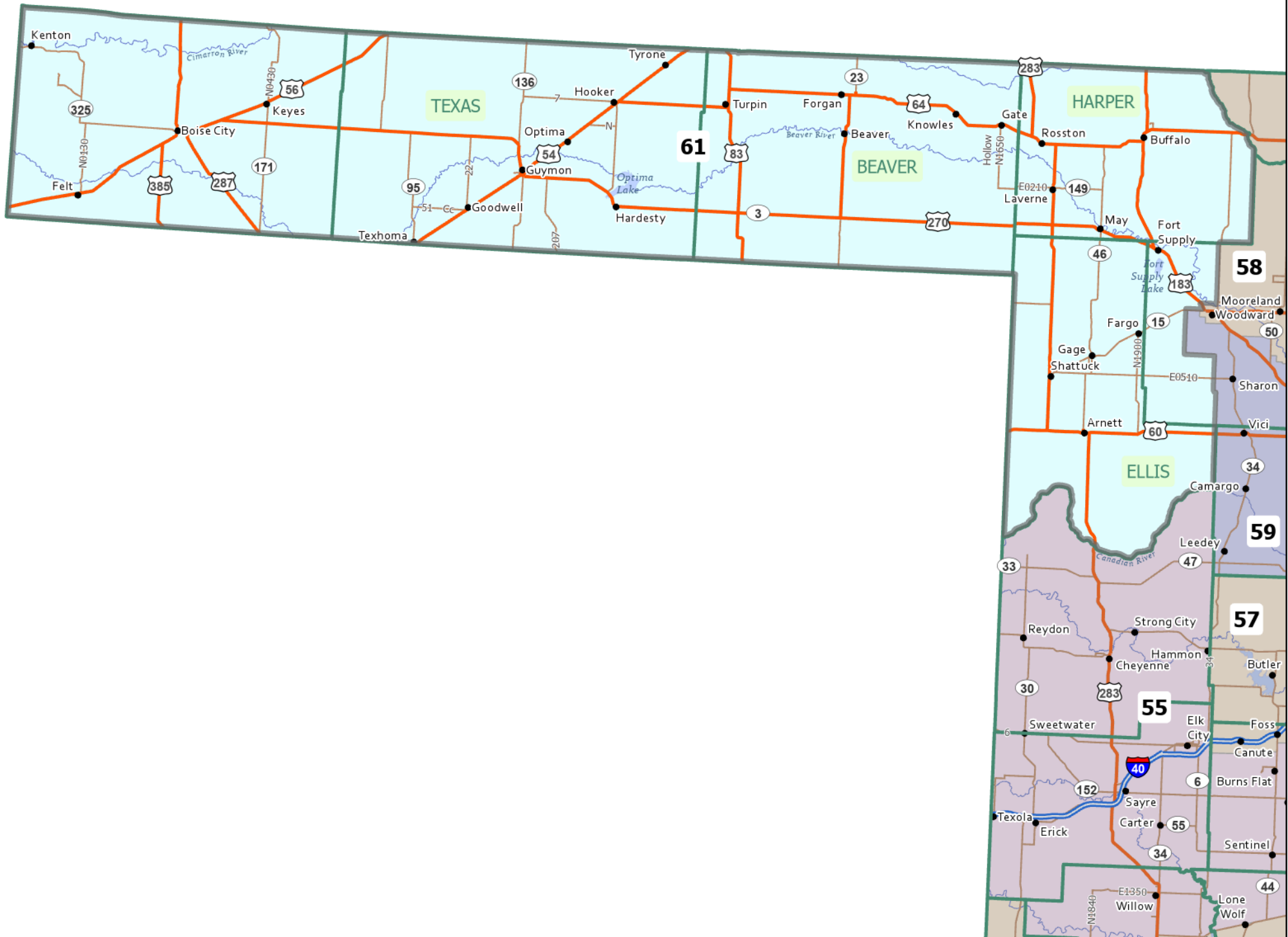

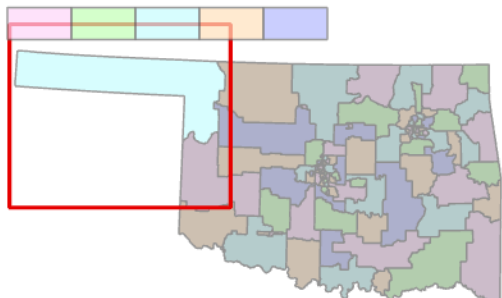
