The ideal district population, **38,939**, is based on the latest population estimate. **HD 68** has **38,825** people, which is **-0.29%** from the ideal. **8%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

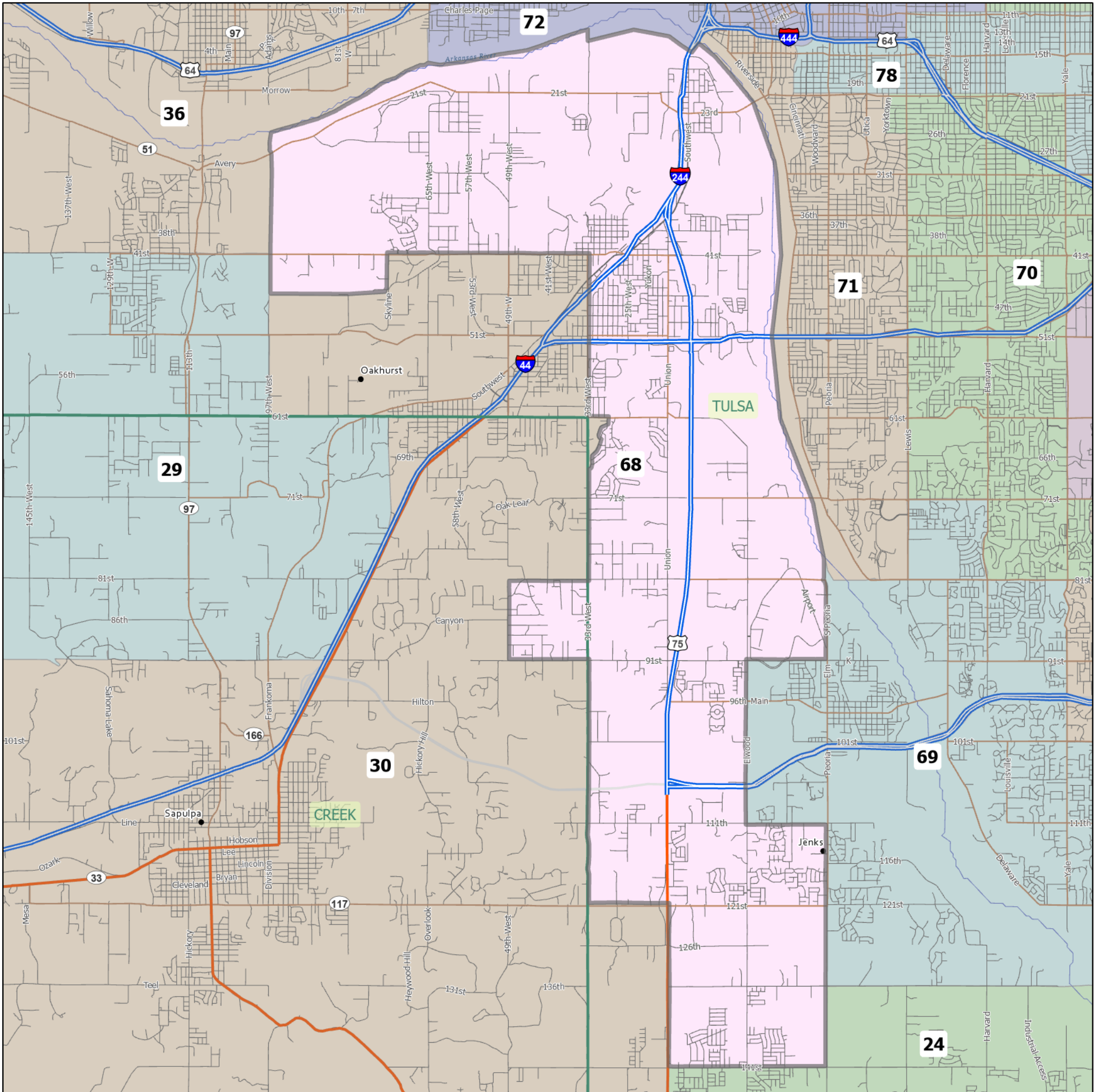
- 13.63% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 8.58% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 67.77% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 1.89% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 7.41% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

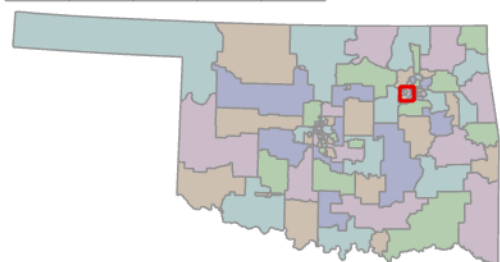
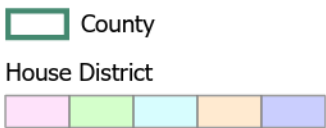
