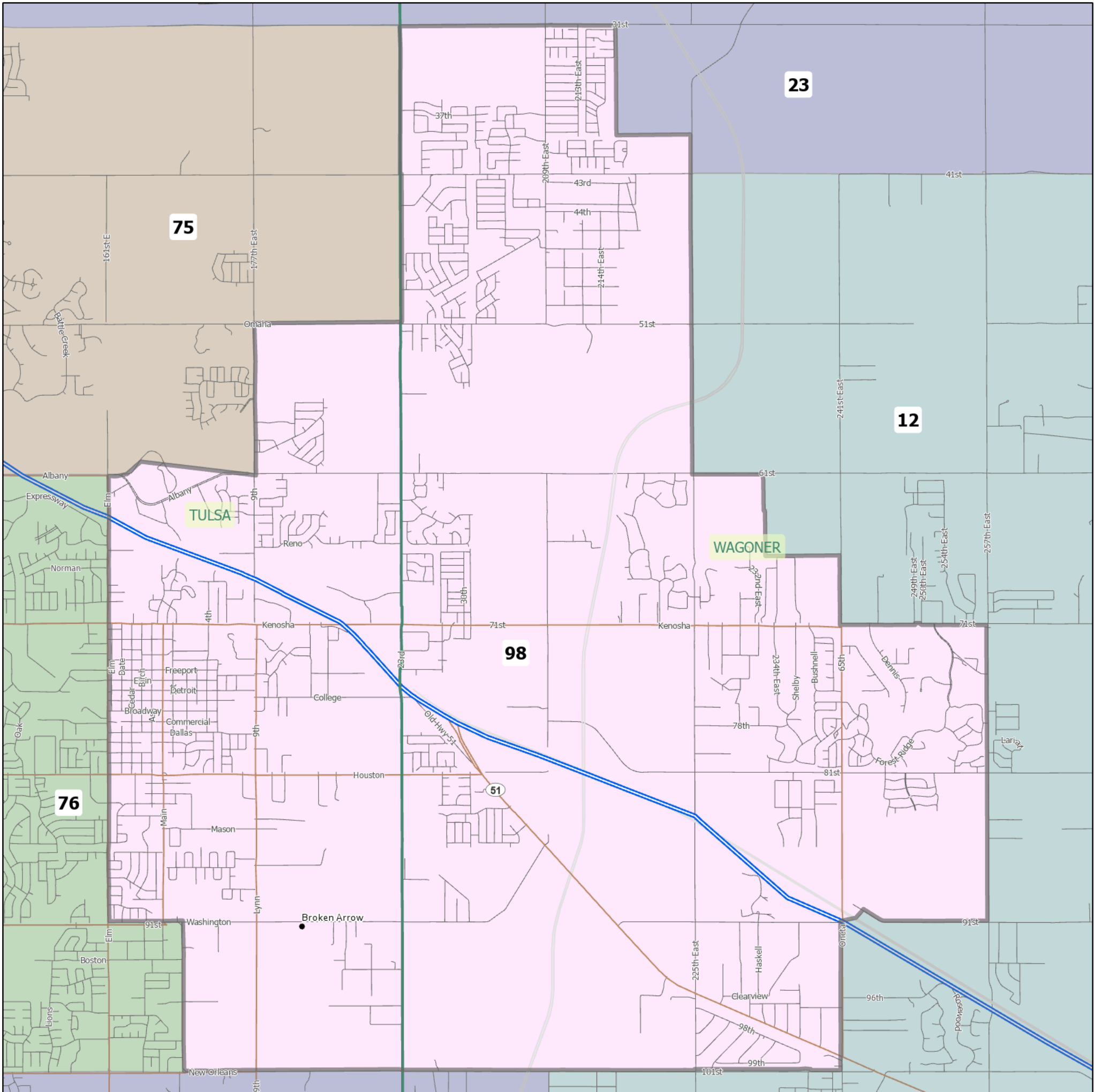
- 12.4% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.

- 69.72% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 2.61% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.

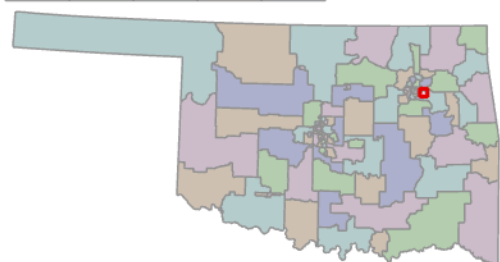
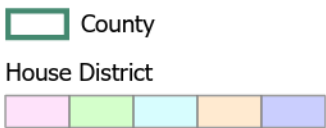
