

House District 20 | 2022–2031

The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.
HD 20 has **38,918** people, which is **-0.72%** from the ideal.
43.69% of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 14.09% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.44% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 3.8% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 0.2% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 74.12% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 5.13% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 6.98% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

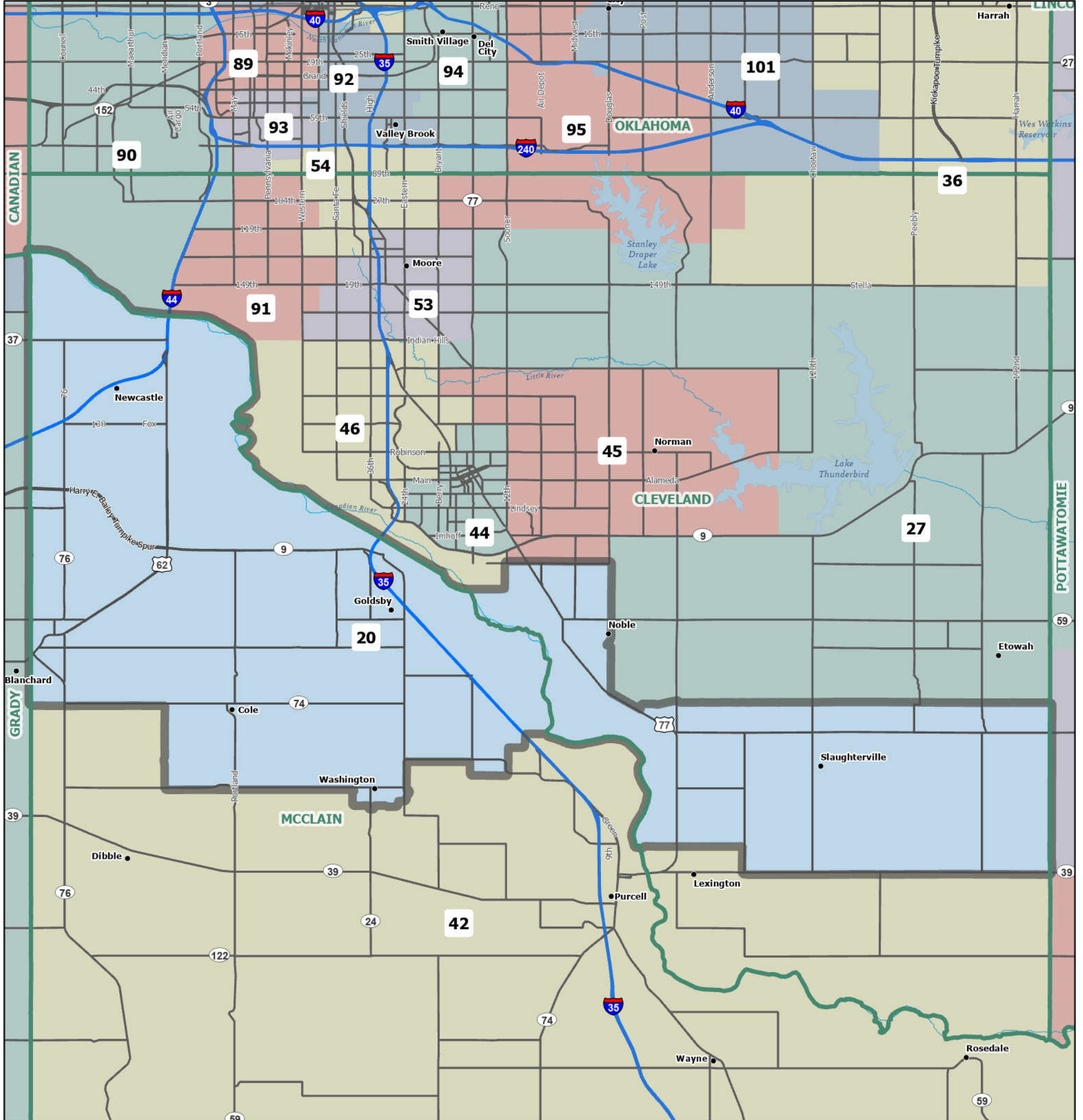

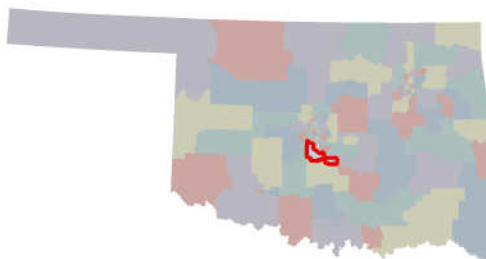
