

# House District 59 | 2022–2031

The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.  
**HD 59** has **38,885** people, which is **-0.81%** from the ideal.  
**27.31%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

- 8.2% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.16% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 3.13% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 1.66% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 74.09% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 9.38% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 12.93% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

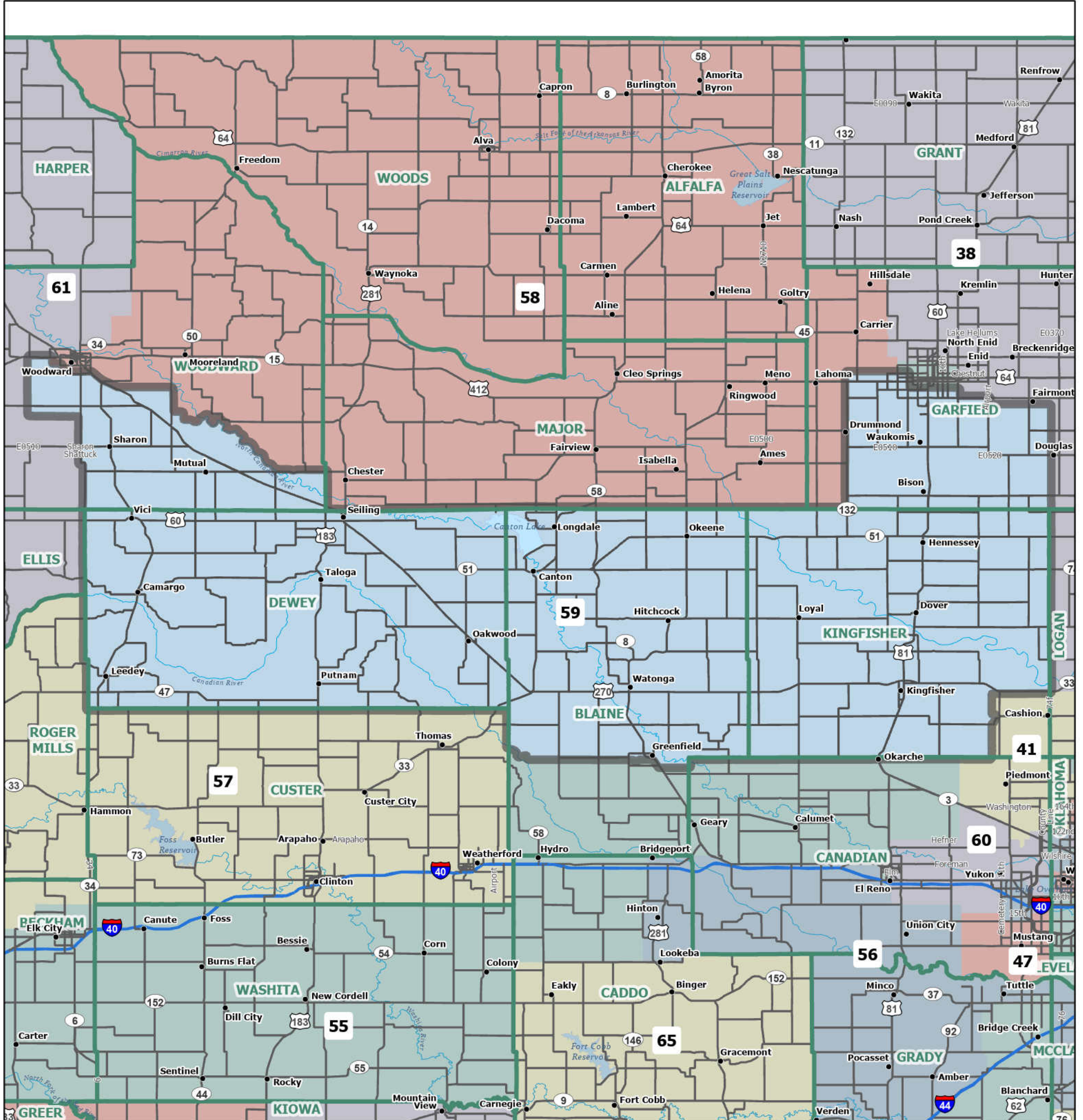

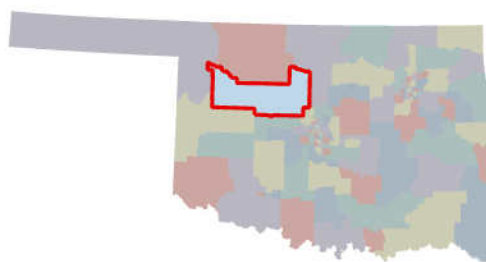
