The ideal district population, **39,202**, is based on the 2020 Census.  
**HD 80** has **39,625** people, which is **1.08%** from the ideal.  
**21.63%** of the people in the district are new constituents.

14.02% of the district is American Indian and Alaskan Native, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 4.67% of the district is Asian, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 7.34% of the district is Black or African American, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 0.17% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.  
 67.2% of the district is non-Hispanic white.  
 6.18% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.  
 7.99% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

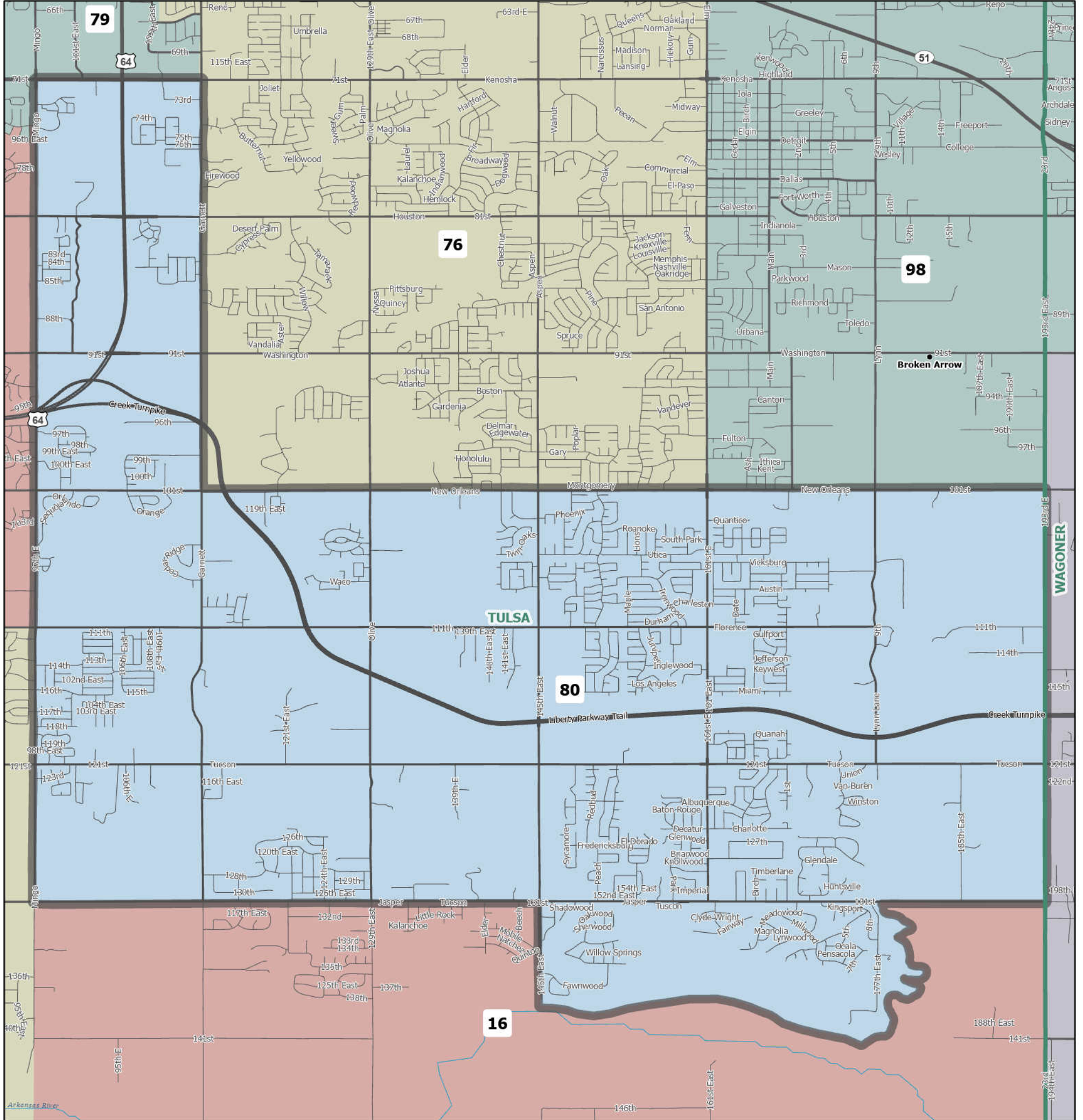

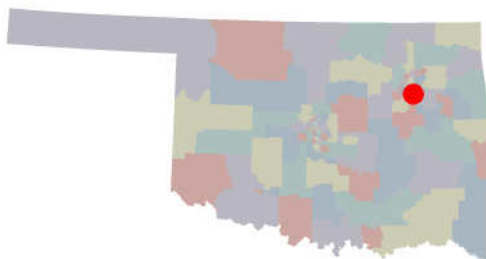
