- 0.14% of the district is Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander, alone or in combination with one or more other races.
- 43.28% of the district is non-Hispanic white.
- 3.17% of the district is some other race or ethnicity.
- 5.29% of the district is of Hispanic or Latino origin.

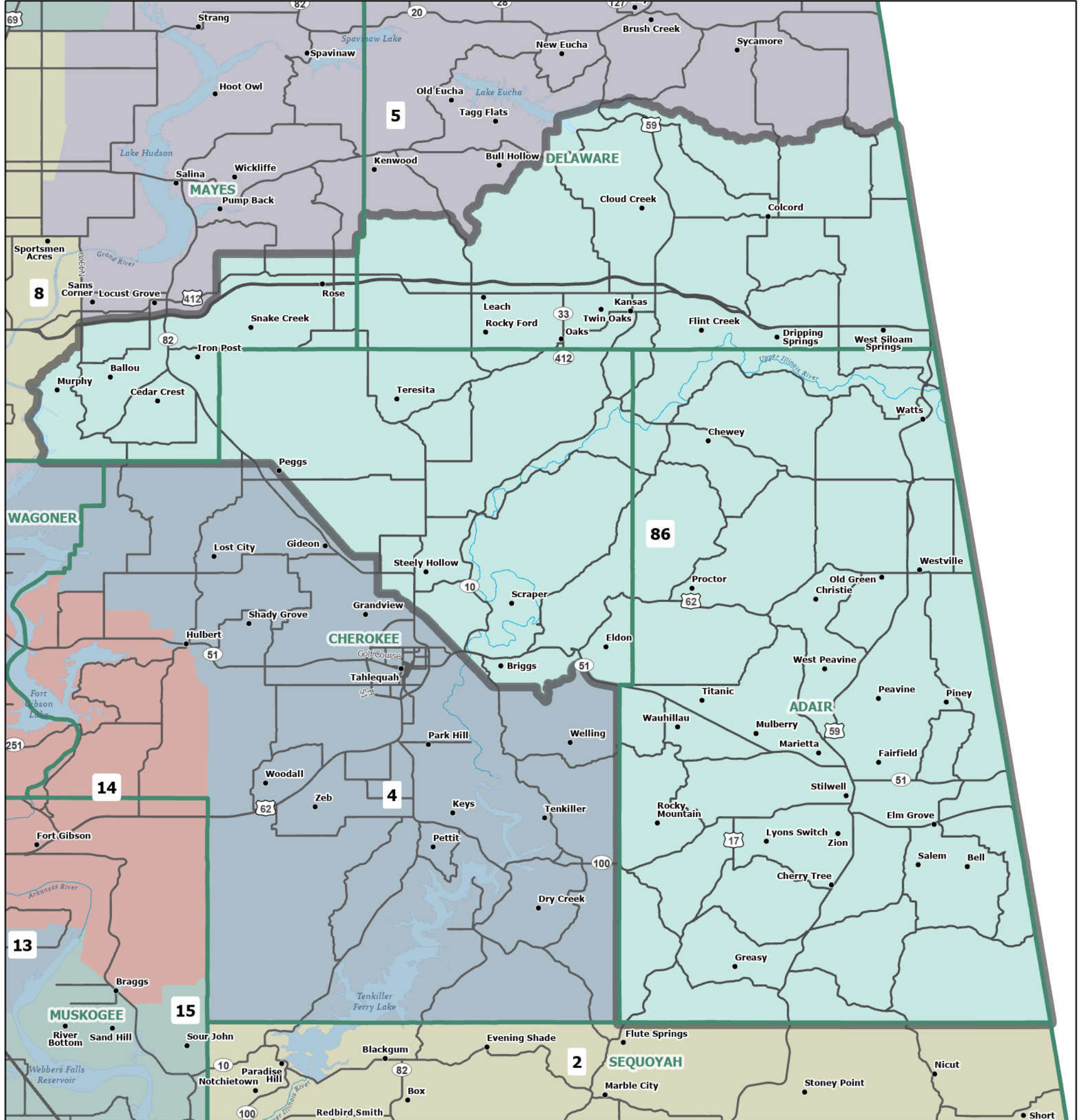

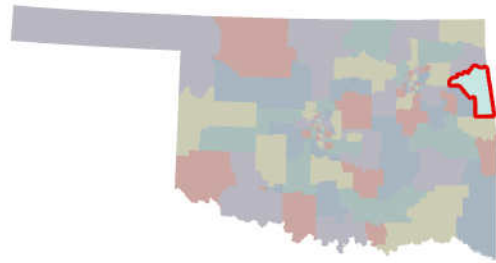
